Welcome back to school and Term 1 2021 for everyone. It is always pleasing to return and see that the students have had a happy, relaxing and most importantly a safe holiday period. It is especially exciting to welcome our 101 new Year 7 students who have joined the Asquith Boys High School family, and are all very excited to be at our wonderful school.

New Staff at Asquith Boys High School

We have 3 new staff joining us at Asquith Boys High School.

- Ms Alison Pritchard has been appointed to the TAS faculty and will be teaching Hospitality and Junior TAS courses.
- Mr Manuel Cabrera has joined our Music faculty, replacing Ms Ursino after she left in Term 4, 2020.
- Mr Tristian Donohoo is replacing Ms Kelly, who will be on leave for Term 1 and 2 in the English faculty.
- Mr Broome is continuing in the important role of Careers Adviser for 2021.
- Ms Hamilton (Librarian) is on leave for Term 1 and Ms Gowthorp and Mr Li will replace her respectively for 3 and 2 days per week.

High Achievers Assembly

Our High Achievers Assembly was held on Friday 5 February. It was really pleasing to see so many of the successful 2020 HSC students and to have the school acknowledge and recognise them for their achievements. The 2020 Dux is Max Xiong with an ATAR of 98.75, and Matthew Hiebl achieved 97.25 and Zoulin Wang 94.30.

Max achieved Band 6 results in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics Extension 1 and 2; Matthew in Engineering Studies, Mathematics Advanced and Mathematics Extension 1; and Zoulin in Chinese and Literature, Mathematics Extension 1 and 2. All excelled throughout the year in all courses and put their success down to dedication and consistent hard work, despite the trying circumstances that they encountered throughout 2020.

Asquith Boys High School achieved 25 HSC Distinguished Achievers with Band 6 results across 16 different subject areas including Construction, Engineering Studies, English Studies, Mathematics, Mathematics Standard 1 and 2, Mathematics Extension 1 and 2, Music, Food Technology, Chemistry, Physics, Investigating Science, PDHPE and Chinese and Literature.

100% of our Advanced Mathematics students achieved the equivalent of Band 5 or higher results as well as 90% of our English Advanced students. Our students also excelled in boys education finishing as the 3rd Comprehensive Boys School in NSW, and above local co-ed schools Ku-ring-gai, Pennant Hills and St Leo's; and only 22 school placings behind Asquith Girls High School which is an incredible effort and result on Asquith Boys High Schools behalf in the 2020 HSC.

Ancient History, Modern History, Hospitality and Food Technology classes were an outstanding 10% above state average, and overall we achieved an incredible 20 out of 28 subjects above state averages, with 7.77% of the student cohort achieving outstanding Band 6 results.

Year 7 Camp

This excitement will continue early next week for our Year 7 students, when they head off to camp on Monday 8 February. This is an excellent opportunity to bond as a group and make new life long friends. It is also an excellent opportunity for Mr Hughes to get to know the entire year group and share in this experience with his students. A special thank you to all the staff attending camp with Mr Hughes and Year 7.

Music Information Evening

The ABHS and AGHS Music Ensembles Information Night was held via Zoom (due to COVID number restrictions) on Wednesday 3 February with 40 students and their parents attending from both schools. Best Start Information

Year 7 will be completing 'Best Start' diagnostic assessments in Week 4. These assessments are designed to greatly assist our staff and inform our teaching of Year 7 for the year ahead. Unfortunately, there will be no official parent and carer reports or notification of results made available, however, some staff may utilise this information in their communications with parents throughout the year. Students will receive written notification of these scheduled examinations in the coming weeks.

Travelling to and from School

In 2021 the school end of day time has changed on Monday, Thursday and Fridays to 2.54pm, which will allow all students to catch the 3.04pm train. The Tuesday 2.22pm and Wednesday 2.20pm (unless you are in a grade sport team) finish times will also ensure that all students can catch the earlier 2.34pm all stops train to Berowra.

Currently in accordance with the state wide public transport guidelines, **all** students are required to wear masks on public transport until further notice. I request that all students comply with this guideline and parents assist by ensuring that your son has a mask for their travels to and from school.

- Follow normal absentee procedures, should your son be too unwell to attend school.
