Information for Enrolments 2026

Dear Parents/Guardians

We have a long tradition of welcoming and enrolling students from the community. In 2026 we will become a coeducational school enrolling girls for the very first time.

Our primary partner schools are Hornsby South, Hornsby North, Hornsby Heights and Mount Colah. However, we have had a long history and association with our now non-local schools, of Asquith, Berowra, Brooklyn, Cowan, Mount Kuring-gai, Normanhurst, Normanhurst West, Waitara and Wideview.

Non-local enrolment applications will be considered to the following criteria:

- Sibling of a student currently enroled at Asquith Boys High School are prioritised, especially if the school has not achieved its enrolment cap.
- Son, daughter or sibling of a former student of Asquith Boys High School.
- Availability of a subject(s) or combination of subjects that can be met at the new co-education High School, but are not available at other schools.
- Compassionate and/or medical circumstances.
- Proximity and access to the school.
- Structure and organisation of the school.

Scholarships Offered in 2026

Year 7 Instrumental Band Scholarship opportunities for your son/daughter if they would like to apply for the scholarship for next year.

One scholarship is offered, covering \$440 of the Annual Band Tuition Fee, for weekly rehearsal in the Stage Band. The Scholarship will be valid for two (2) years and subject to an annual review. For a student to retain their Scholarship they must show exemplary conduct, progress and effort in his academic work, attendance at all band rehearsals and participation in all band activities. Tutoring, preparation and practice of their instrument and all pieces are expectations which must be upheld. They are required to continue the development of their abilities across musical performance as well as reading and examinations. Concert tours, camps and performances are not covered by the Scholarship. Any additional Band Tuition fees will need to be covered by the parents.

PREREQUISITES - Students must have:-

- Grade 3 AMEB or equivalent
- Ability to cope satisfactorily with academic aspects of all schoolwork.

- Proven capacity in Music
- Perform for the school at all opportunities and contribute to music program.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

All applicants will be required to attend an audition/interview, to play two short contrasting pieces and scales on their chosen instrument. There will also be some sight-reading, listening and a general discussion.
